Building a Community

From its beginnings 92 years ago, Easter Settlement has been about building a community of Friends. Settlement means different things to different people: a restful break from a hectic working life, or a stimulating change from a quiet retirement; the chance to catch up with old friends or to get to know new people; a time for contemplation and reflection, or for late night dancing and long walks along the cliffs. All these are ingredients of the mix that makes a new community each year.

All Age Activities

Children and young people will be taking part in activities with adult Friends and will also have sessions with their own group. In all-age groups everyone's contribution matters, whatever their age or experience.

Children and Young People

Children and young people are the responsibility of their parents or carer, except during the organised sessions for their age group. Under 11s must be signed in at the beginning of a session and collected promptly afterwards.

The children's group co-ordinators would welcome help with activities. If you would like to get involved with one or more sessions of the 0-5s or 6-11s group, please note on the form how you could help and whether you have been CRB checked through Britain Yearly Meeting or your Local Meeting.

Part Stays & Day Visitors

If you would like to come to Easter Settlement but are unable to stay for the full weekend, please contact Chris Petrie to confirm the appropriate charge.

Day visitors are welcome for all or part of the weekend. A day charge of £15 covers lunch, hot drinks and a contribution towards the general running costs of the gathering. Day visitors may book an evening meal direct with Cober Hill on (01723) 870310.

Shared Rooms

Most of the rooms at Cober Hill accommodate two to four people. Cots can be provided for the very young. Older children and young people may share with their family or with others their own age. Let us know if your child would like to share with a friend.

There are a few single rooms but these are very popular, so please book early if you require one. If you are coming to Easter Settlement alone but would be happy to share a room with another person, please include on the booking form any extra details that would help us to arrange a suitable room share - for example whether you are a night owl or early riser.
