## Directions to The Mount School



### **By rail:**

York station is ten to fifteen minutes walk from The Mount. Turn right towards Micklegate Bar; turn right up Blossom Street and The Mount, then turn right into Dalton Terrace.

### **By road:**

Enter the school car park from Driffield Terrace (off Dalton Terrace). Some extra parking is available on Love Lane. Otherwise, use the Askham Bar park and ride service. This is most convenient if you are approaching from south or east: turn on to the A1036 (signed for 'York West') and look out for the Askham Bar Park & Ride service close to Tesco. The bus will drop you on Tadcaster Road / The Mount near Dalton Terrace and 200m from The Mount.
